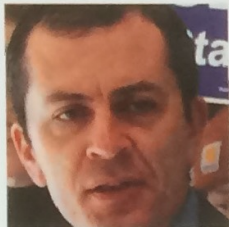


DOES BEN CHIPMAN STAND FOR DEMOCRATIC VALUES?



Why did he take money from Republicans to defeat a Democratic tax plan?

State Senate candidate Ben Chipman took **\$7,577.50** from a right-wing PAC to collect signatures to defeat a Democratic tax plan that would have helped thousands of Portland families.* The PAC's contributors include Gov. LePage, Tea Party leaders and the Maine Republican Party.



Why does he switch parties so much — including to Democrat at the last minute?

Chipman only became a Democrat *last September* — just in time to run for the State Senate. As a member of the Green Party, he did the *same thing* in 2010 — switching to Independent to run for the State House.

Who is the real Ben Chipman? Just two years ago, Chipman said, “I have never been a Democrat or a Republican and don’t see the need to register [with a party].” *Portland Press Herald, 10/27/14*
