White House Restaurant reopens

JONESBORO — As the Covanta Biomass energy plant closed, the White House Restaurant opened.

Restaurant owner "Buck" Proctor said he worked for Covanta off and on for 29 years and

learned in January that the plant was closing

"[April 27] was my last day at work, and [April 28] we opened this place," he said.

The restaurant is open 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday through

Sunday. Proctor said business was good the first week with every seat

filled on two of the four nights. By May 4, more than 25 people had made reservations for Mother's Day on May 8.

"Now that the local people know we're open, I'm sure they'll spread the word," he said.

Proctor purchased the restaurant 15 years ago. He ran it until his divorce after which it remained closed for five or six years. While it was closed, he paid the mortgage by renting the building to Whitney Wreaths to house migrant workers, he said.

"I knew I had to do something with [the building]," he said. "I had the mortgage.'

In December 2014, at the suggestion of a friend, he decided to remodel and reopen. The restaurant was open last summer for only nine weeks, however, because not enough employees were available.

"The help ran out," Proctor said. "They went back to school."

This year, he said, he is pleased to report he has three experienced cooks and other experienced workers lined up for the summer. Manv of them have worked for him be-

He described having enough help as a "big sigh of relief," saying last summer's nine weeks of

operation were a "struggle."

Because Proctor has no full-time job now, he plans to keep the restaurant open until at least the fall and possibly all year. The restaurant will be open seven days per week during the summer, but he said he was uncertain what days he will maintain in the fall.

Before he lost his job, Proctor said, he listed the restaurant for sale with a real estate agent. He would still consider serious offers but is on the fence about selling.

Part of him wants to retire and return to South Carolina to be near his father. The other part wants to continue to run the restaurant.

"In a way it would be nice to just kind of retire," said Proctor, who will be 66 in June.

On the other hand, he said he invested about \$100,000 in new flooring, plumbing, fixtures and decorations while remodeling.

"It would be really good to run

this and get some of my investment back this summer," he said.

He does not want to sell the building to anyone who does not want to actually run a restaurant there, he said.

"I'd like to see the place up and going in good hands," he said.

Proctor recalled that while the restaurant was closed, many local people would ask him when it was going to reopen.

'We have a bunch of the older crowd that have been coming here for years," he said, adding these are some of the same customers who came when it was open years ago.

Among them is Richard Kelley of Whitneyville, who said he is glad the restaurant reopened. He enjoys stopping for a cup of coffee and chatting with whoever is there.

"I enjoy the people. It's real Down East," he said.

He rarely eats out but when he does, he enjoys the hamburgers and hot dogs the White House serves, he said

The restaurant also serves seafood, pulled pork and daily specials such as meatloaf, lasagna and chicken alfredo, Proctor said.

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There are wood pellet manufacturers in the South, "but we're three days closer to Europe than some of those ports," he said, making such an enterprise even more attractive to investors.

Manufacturing wind turbine blades also might make sense for the Bucksport site, Gelinas said, and Bucksport "would be an ideal manufacturing site for those.

Cianbro, which operates a facility at which it manufactures modular-built industrial structures on the Penobscot River in Brewer, then ships them by barge, is another example of what might be done in Bucksport, Gelinas said.

If manufacturing is established there, a new dry cargo dock would be needed, and that's where significant investment would be needed. The existing "wet" dock, which allows for the offloading of petroleum fuels, "was pretty much purpose-built," Gelinas said, probably about 70 years ago, when the paper mill began using No. 6 oil, and probably could not be repur-

But the 35-foot depths in the harbor are not in need of dredging, Gelinas said, which makes the location as viable as Searsport, Eastport and Portland, the three ports the state decided to focus its investment on back in the 1970s.

"Bucksport got orphaned" by that strategy, he said.

"It's pretty hard to see one company coming and replacing those [paper mill] jobs," Gelinas said, but a consortium of businesses shipping and manufacturing could thrive.

"There's going to be a lot of ideas floated out there," Gelinas said, "but it's going to take a real commitment on the part of someone."

Health care rise offsets energy drop

Wall Street ended mixed on Monday after a rally in Allergan Plc. and other health care companies offset a decline in energy shares. Five of 10 S&P sectors ended high-

er, led by the health sector's 1.13 percent increase, while energy and materials sectors both tumbled 1.25 percent. Allergan surged 5.98 percent.

Teva Pharmaceutical Industries Ltd. said it still expected its \$40.5 billion acquisition of Allergan's generic drug business to close in June.

Chevron Corp. fell 1.48 percent as U.S. crude prices dropped 2.8 percent and traders assessed the impact of wildfires on Canada's oil output and a build in inventory.

A bigger-than-expected drop in China's imports and exports in April pointed to weak demand in the world's second-biggest economy and weighed on materials stocks.

Caterpillar dropped 3.52 percent, weighing the most on the Dow industrials.

The Dow Jones industrial average ended down 0.2 percent at 17,705.91 points while the S&P 500 edged up 0.08 percent to 2,058.69.

The Nasdaq Composite added 0.3 percent to 4,750.21, helped by a 2.45 percent rally in the Nasdaq biotech index.

After the bell, solar panel company SolarCity, co-founded by technology billionaire Elon Musk, offered a first-quarter report that disappointed investors, sending its stock down 13 percent.
