A book clip designed and made by Munksgaard used approximately 1-inch-square piece of copper. It was stamped with "ME 1910," to designate the year the Capitol was completed, and attached to an antiqued brass bookclip. She also designed and handcrafted a beaded necklace that has as its centerpiece an oval piece of copper about 2½ by 1½ inches in size. The necklace itself is strung with alternating aventurine gemstones and antiqued copper beads.

Reigstad created a pendant with matching earrings sold as a set, Munksgaard said. The rectangleshaped copper pieces have a solid green patina and a variegated piece of copper riveted on top it. The variegated piece is from a different part of the roof.

The cost of items made

\$100 for necklaces that include beads and other metals, such as brass.

The gallery has donated nearly \$30,000 to the library for its current renovation project from the sale of those items, Munksgaard said. The library gave Maine Jewelry & Art the copper in exchange for a portion of the profits.

It does not have a similar deal with the state. The gallery is purchasing the copper from the State House dome for \$10 per square foot, according to Grant Pennoyer, executive director of the Legislative Council, which oversees operations at the Capitol. Other artists may do the same, he said Dec. 9.

Originally, the copper from the State House dome was to be sold as scrap for an estimated \$21,000, Penusing copper from both nover said. The council buildings range from \$20 came up with a multi-

for a tie tack to more than pronged approach that included saving about 2,500 square feet of copper for a public arts project that is in the early planning stages, selling several to artists and art schools and creating commemorative plaques that include photos of the dome and a piece of the copper that are being sold through the council's office.

> We hope that by selling the copper, we can bring in the amount we would have gotten if we'd sold it all for scrap," Pennoyer said. "We did scrap some that was not suitable for resale for about \$1,200."

The original State House dome, which included about 7,000 square feet of copper, was installed between 1909 and 1910, according to a previously published report. It was replaced last year at a cost of about \$1.4 million, according to Pennoyer.
