#### Celebrating our heritage

From Sept. 15 to Oct. 15, we celebrate National Hispanic Heritage Month. Sept. 15 is the anniversary of independence in five Latin American countries: Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras and Nicaragua. Mexico, Chile and Belize also celebrate their independence in September.

# Cook's Corner

### **Bueno Huevos Burrito**

#### You'll need:

- Cooking spray
- 2 large eggs
- 1/4 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 4 slices bacon, crumbled
- 2 (8-inch) tortillas
- · 2 tablespoons reduced-fat cream cheese
- 2 tablespoons mild salsa

#### What to do:

- 1. Spray skillet with cooking spray. Scramble 2 eggs with cheese.
- 2. Cook bacon in microwave according to directions; crumble into small pieces.
- 3. Spread 1 tablespoon cream cheese on each tortilla.
- 4. Microwave for 8 to 10 seconds to warm tortilla and cream cheese.
- 5. Divide eggs and crumbled bacon between the 2 tortillas.
- 6. Spoon 1 tablespoon of salsa on top of each tortilla. Roll each into a cylinder.


