

# Cook's Corner

**Corny Cheese Soup** 

# You'll need:

- 2 (11-ounce) cans whole yellow corn
- 1 (10-ounce) can condensed cheddar cheese soup
- 2 cups chicken broth
- 1 cup reduced-fat milk
- 6 slices cooked bacon, crumbled
- 18 to 24 tortilla chips, crushed

# What to do:

- 1. Add corn, condensed soup, chicken broth and milk to a large soup pot.
- 2. Heat slowly to boiling, stirring frequently.
- 3. After boiling, reduce heat and allow to simmer for 8 to 10 minutes.
- 4. Meanwhile, cook bacon according to directions.
- 5. Pour soup into individual bowls. Top with crumbled bacon and crushed chips divided evenly among the bowls. Makes 6 servings.
