CONCISE SUMMARY: This rule is being proposed to comply with the implementation of hospice payment reforms as set out in the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services Rule, 42 CFR §418.302, 306. The final rule requires that State Medicaid programs make revisions to their methodologies for determining the payment rate for Routine Home Care (RHC) and other services. These changes include a new payment methodology for Routine Home Care (RHC) to implement two rates that will result in 1) a higher base payment for the first sixty (60) days of hospice care and 2) a reduced base rate for days thereafter. A new Service Intensity Add-on (SIA) payment for services provided by a Registered Nurse (RN) or clinical social worker during the last seven (7) days of a member's life has also been added. This rule proposes a retroactive effective date of January 1, 2016.
