Notice is hereby given that the Lincoln Town Council will hold a public hearing on Monday, September 28, 2015 at 7:00 PM at the Council Chambers, 63 Main Street, Lincoln, for the purpose of hearing oral and written comments to consider the adoption of an order enti-tled "Town of Lincoln Order 2015-1" which authorizes the appropriation of funds in an amount not to exceed \$1,150,000. Both the public hearing and Town Council meetings are open to the public. A copy of the order will be made available to the public, once approved at the office of the Town Clerk and is available for public inspection during regular office hours. Pursuant to Article VIII, Section 801 of the Town Charter, the order and appropriation of funds shall be submitted for approval by the voters of the Town of Lincoln at a Referendum Election to be held on November 3, 2015. which authorizes the appropriation of November 3, 2015.

QUESTION 1: Shall the Order 2015-1 of the Lincoln Town Council, authorizing the Town to lease the Courthouse located at 52 Main Street by appropriating up to \$250,000 of unappropriated fund balance and designated reserve accounts and entering into a ten year lease purchase contract, and calling for the Town to borrow up to \$700,000 to finance improvements to bring the finance improvements to bring the Courthouse into compliance with the Town and State Building Codes and the Americans With Disabilities Act, so that the Courthouse may be used as the Town Office, be approved?

SUMMARY: The Town wishes to acquire the Courthouse for use as a Town Office. To do this, the Town will make a down payment of \$250,000 and enter into a ten-year lease purchase agreement, paying approximately \$2,070 per month, for a total cost of approximately \$500,000. In order to use the Courthouse as a Town Office, the Town will be required to install an elevator to make it accessible to persons with disabilities and to make various repairs. abilities and to make various repairs and improvements in order to bring it into compliance with the Town and State Building Codes. The cost of the elevator and other required repairs and improvements will be \$700,000. To pay for them the Town will be required. for them, the Town will borrow \$700,000. Upon approval of the Town's Downtown Tax Increment Financing district and this expenditure by the Town and the Maine Department of Economic and Community Development, the Town intends to use TIF rev enues to repay the loan over ten years

The National Museum of Natural History (NMNH) of the Smithsonian Institution plans to repatriate the skeletal remains of three individuals and 454 funerary objects from Maine to the Wabanaki Tribes of Maine representing the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe and the Penobscot Indian Nation.

The remains of one individual were exhumed from the Jonesboro Site 61-2 near Jonesboro, Maine at an unknown date by L.A. Watts and were sent to the museum in 1966. Evidence indicates they date to the Late Ceramic period. The human remains of at least two individuals and four associated funerary objects were excavated from Lower Torrey's Island in Penobscot Bay, Hancock County, Maine, in 1896 by Frank Cushing of the Smithsonian Institution. Evidence indicates they date to the Late Ceramic period. In 1899 Cushing also removed 62 blue glass beads and an iron knife dating to ca. 1615-1650 from a Native American burial in a shell heap," on Campbell's Island, in Penobscot Bay, Hancock County, Maine. In 1869 Captain John Michener donated to the museum a copper kettle found in a grave near Eastport, Washington County, Maine. The kettle dated to the late 1600s. These remains and funerary objects are believed by a preponderance of the evidence to be culturally affiliated with the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe.

In 1938 Judge William Graham donated to the museum 386 glass beads dating to the late 1600s which were collected from an "Indian Cemetery," at Norridgewock, Somerset County, Maine. This site was probably the Old Mission Village at Norridgewock (1697-1724). Descendants of the Norridgewock inhabitants are found today among the Penobscot Indian Nation and the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe.

After consultation with the Wabanaki Tribes of Maine representing the Aroostook Band of Micmacs, the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians, the Penobscot Indian Nation, and the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe, and a review of the available evidence, the remains and objects have been found by a preponderance of the evidence to be culturally affiliated to the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe and/or the Penobscot Indian Nation. The remains of three individuals and 454 funerary objects will be repatriated to the Wabanaki Tribes of Maine representing the Passamaquoddy Indian Tribe and the Penobscot Indian Nation.
