Vitamin supplementation not required

Dear Dr. Roach: Will a DR. KEITH ROACH blood test reveal deficiencies in levels of vitamins D and C, magnesium, Co-Q10, etc.?

Vitamin levels can be measured in the blood, but it is seldom necessary to do so. There are some exceptions. Vitamin D remains controversial, with most experts recommending checking vitamin D levels in people at risk for deficiency (including dark-skinned individuals, those who seldom get sun exposure and people who take medications that interfere with vitamin D or who do not absorb it properly, such as those with sprue or inflammatory bowel disease). Many experts recommend vitamin D supplementation in healthy adults, but it is still not clear whether this is necessary.

Vitamin C is rarely deficient from diet (scurvy), but it can be seen in cases nols seem to work. Why is of severe malabsorption. Co-

TO YOUR GOOD HEALTH

Q10 is almost never measured outside of research settings. Magnesium deficiency is common in people taking diuretics. In general, vitamin blood levels are not necessary to check in healthy people. With the possible exception of vitamin D, most people with a healthy diet do not need vitamin supplementation.

Dear Dr. Roach: Why do we not see studies on plant sterols and stanols as a way of reducing cholesterol? I take a pill supplement, CholestOff, and also eat foods with plant sterols and stanols. Plus, I take fish oil and folic acid. My cholesterol decreased by 35 percent, and I no longer have to take a statin. My HDL is about 80. The sterol/stathis not well-known, and why

Plant sterols and stanols can lower blood cholesterol, although most people will see a drop of about 6 percent to 15 percent rather than the 35 percent you saw. Plant sterols and stanols are better absorbed with fat, so they are often used in margarines, but can be used in pill form with lecithin, which helps absorp-

The reasons doctors typically don't recommend them are that there have not been any long-term safety studies. And although they do lower cholesterol, there isn't any proof that they reduce risk of heart attack. There have been several medications that lower cholesterol but increase risk of adverse events

Reported side effects of plant sterol and stanol tablets include heartburn, nausea, constipation and erectile

dysfunction in men. A statin drug is likely to have more effect on cholesterol, probably at lower cost, and with a similar low risk of side effects, vet has been proven to reduce heart attack in people at high risk for heart disease. In my opinion, plant sterol and stanol supplements are a useful adjunct treatment in those who can't tolerate a statin or those in whom the response has been insufficient.

In the Blue Ribbon Pairs at the Fall Championships, most Souths played at 3NT. Many pairs use a style in which a new-suit response at the two level forces to game, and South's 2NT was forcing.

At most tables, South won the second spade and led the jack of hearts. West grabbed his ace, and the defense cashed two spades. When East next led a club, declarer had to guess: If the hearts were running, he had the rest, but if a defender still had the guarded ten. South needed the club finesse

WINNING PLAY

As reported in the "Daily Bulletin" by Barry Rigal, some declarers made the winning play, others failed. South might have done better to lead his four of hearts at Trick Three. If West rose with the ace, South would be home. If instead the king held, dummy could lead a low heart. As the cards lay, East would discard, and declarer would know he needed the club finesse.

If East had the ace of hearts, South would be back to guessing, but he would have given himself an extra chance.

ANSWER: Two diamonds isn't
