

Dear Dr. Roach: My doctor DR. KEITH ROACH has put me on atorvastatin 20 mg. I am 71, with high blood pressure, and my HDL (good cholesterol) is in the 30s. My total cholesterol is now good, at around 180.

After some research, I found out that if you have a thyroid condition, you might not need to take cholesterol medication. I am concerned about this, but I find it hard to get in contact with my doctor, since she works only two days a week now. Should I be concerned about this, or just keep taking the medicine? — A.C.

About 5 percent of all people with high cholesterol have unrecognized low thyroid levels, so everybody should get their thyroid checked before going on cholesterol medication.
