

Dear Dr. Roach: In the past DR. KEITH ROACH few years, I've been experiencing "volatile blood pressure." It will go from 71/38 to 280/90 in half an hour. It happens in all situations. I could be knitting and do a check, and it will be 200/68. The emergency and ambulance teams know me very well. I have had 24hour urine tests and lots of bloodwork. Most of the time it is low, so how can I raise it up? I was on 25 milligrams of Cozaar (losartan), but it caused a real dive. Do you have any advice on how to control this? — P.D.
