signals. Today's South leaped boldly to four hearts over East's double. West led the king of spades, and East signaled with the jack. West continued with the eight to the ace, and East next led the king of diamonds: five, deuce, nine.

East then led ... a third spade. South ruffed, led a club to dummy, and claimed.

### **UNHAPPY**

East-West were unhappy. West said his deuce of diamonds signaled — an odd number of diamonds — so East should have cashed his ace. But West knew the ace would surely cash — East was unlikely to have six diamonds — and West knew a third spade would not. Might he have signaled with the ten "attitude," diamonds,

**ANSWER:** Partner would not bid a second time without game interest. You have a sound hand and can cooperate, but you should not jump to four hearts with three-card support. A bid of four diamonds is possible. Your best bid is three spades, showing spade strength and leaving room to reach 3NT.
