The City of Rockland is searching for a Harbormaster. This position has general control and responsibility for ensuring the smooth operation of Rockland Harbor and enforcing related City ordinances while observing state and federal laws. There are both administrative and enforcement duties. The administration role has two parts, one as a City department manager, and the other as the person that administers the harbor related fee orders. The enforcement role requires maintaining order and ensuring that the City's harbor related rules and ordinances are followed.

POSITION SUMMARY:

The Harbormaster has the following primary responsibilities: Seeks opportunities to promote Rockland as a port of access with availability of services, public and private, for every level of potential commercial fishing, passenger transportation, commercial cargo, walking, recreational boating, etc. Promotes harbor safety initiatives. Investigates and pursues opportunities to enhance protection of waterfront and vessels within the harbor from environmental and meteorological threats. Maintains liaison with Rockland Port District on matters of passenger and freight transportation in the port. Prepares rules and regulations for keeping open channels for passage of vessels in harbor, for establishment of boundary lines of channels, and for assignment of suitable portions of harbor for anchorage, and enforces the rules once approved. Works with the USCG, the Rockland Police Department and the Rockland Fire Department to enforce City, State and Federal laws; publishes and distributes printed rules and regulations of the port as approved; Develops and administers municipal harbor budget, and collects and accounts for revenues generated by activities. Administers mooring assignments. Staffs and operates as a facility for transient vessels daily from July 1- September 10. Installs floats prior to May 15 and removes prior to November 15 each year. Staffs and operates the boat launch ramp at Snow Marine Park as a facility to launch and retrieve trailer borne vessels daily from July 1 – September 10. Maintains and operates Middle Pier as facility where vessels carrying passengers may operate from May 15 to October 15. Administers and operates the Municipal Fish Pier to ensure service to local commercial fishing industry. Maintains the serviceability to enhance opportunities to expand and strengthen Harbor Park, Buoy Park, and Snow Marine Park. Provides municipal liaison to users and customers of harbor, as well as with Maine Department of Transportation, Maine Department of Environmental protection, Maine Bureau of Public Lands, and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to ensure compliance with regulations governing harbor use.


QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED FOR POSITION:

- Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice, Marine Conservation, Marine Transportation, Marine Maintenance, or a related field, or the equivalent in education and related work experience in law enforcement, marine conservation, marine construction, marine transportation, marine maintenance, commercial fishing, or as a merchant marine or US Navy Seaman.
- Possession of a current United States Coast Guard Master's license preferred.
- USCG Homeland Security Course required (may be taken after hire).
- Maine Maritime Academy annual training required.

- Ability to interact courteously with the public and to establish and maintain effective work relationships with Municipal officials, other employees, and outside agencies.
