## 'ARTober' to celebrate month of arts in Bangor

The Bangor City Council has formally declared the month of October as 'ARTober,' a month long celebration of arts and

culture in the Queen City. Planned by the Bangor Commission on Cultural Development, the celebration will showcase more than 80 mostly free events and exhibitions, including live performances, art exhibits, lectures and workshops at more than 30 venues across the city.

"It's an opportunity for the community to endorse the inherent value of arts and culture [and] praise their contribution to society," said Caitlin Brooke, the city's business development specialist and downtown coordinator, and city liason to the cultural commission.

In June, the cultural commission received a \$10,000 grant from the Maine Community Founprogramming related to ARTober. That doubles the commission's annual budget appropriation from the City Council of \$10,000.

Venues for ARTober events include the University of Maine Museum of Art, the Bangor Opera House, Bangor International Airport, the Bangor Mall, Bangor Public Library, galleries, public parks, churches and numerous local restaurants, bars, shops and other businesses.


