

### Run For Shelter 5k set for Bangor City Forest, benefits Hope House

Penobscot Community Health Care's Hope House Health and Living Center is hosting its first-ever Run for Shelter 5k Run/Walk at 10 a.m., Oct. 17, in the Bangor City Forest (Tripp Drive Entrance-East Trail Parking Lot). The event is sponsored by Varney's, BJ's Wholesale, and the School House Antique Mall to promote awareness of the need to support homeless individuals within our community. Funds raised from the event will assist homeless individuals who have substance abuse and/or mental health issues receive shelter, food, basic necessities and healthcare support at Hope House Health and Living Center.

To register for the 5k walk/run, go to Active.com or register in person between 8 a.m. and 9:45 a.m. on the day of race. The first 50 participants will receive a long-sleeved tech shirt.

The registration fees are as follows: individual walker \$16, individual runner \$21, or group/family run \$61. Awards and prizes are available for the top three finishers. Water and snacks will be available at the race.

### Faith of our Neighbors forums set for Bangor

The workshop will be on Monday, October 19, 2015 from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the Rock & Art Shop (32 Central Street, Bangor).

SPACE Gallery created The Kindling Fund to support the energy of Maine's visual arts community by funding innovative, artist-organized projects that engage the public in ways

that are both inventive and meaningful. The Kindling Fund values risk and experimentation, unconventional engagement, and critical dialogue, and encourages collaborative efforts to reach new audiences, increase public interaction, facilitate dialogue between artists, and create new models for presenting artists' work.

The Fund seeks to support a variety of publicly accessible projects, with a strong interest in alternative space/practices and site-specific presentations that don't fit in established institutions or venues. Projects supported by The Kindling Fund may include (but are not limited to): curatorial projects that focus on unconventional artistic practice; public art projects, intervention or site specific installations; the publication of writing directly related to the visual arts including printed matter and online publications; artist residencies; unconventional exhibitions.
