## Old Town High School football obtains home-field advantage in regional playoffs

OLD TOWN, Maine — T.J. Crawford rushed for 182 yards and two touchdowns Friday night as Old Town capped off an undefeated regular season with a 31-8 victory over Mount Desert Island of Bar Harbor at Victory Field.

“We all believe in each other,” said Old Town senior quarterback Jake Jarvis after guiding coach Lance Cowan’s club to its eighth win Friday, Nov. 23. “We’ve just had to go out each week and play one game at a time, just play to be 1-0 each week.”

The Old Town Coyotes earned the No. 1 seed in Class C North after winning a coin flip with Winslow after the Black Raiders’ 35-0 victory over Waterville on Saturday — meaning Old Town will have home-field advantage throughout the regional playoffs.

Both Old Town and defending Class C state champion Winslow are 8-0 but because they did not meet, had identical schedules and the same record, the coin flip was the final means of determining seeding between the teams.

### ROOFTOP GARDEN RELOCATION

Members of the John Bapst football team traded the field one day last week for a rooftop. Instead of running plays, they shoveled dirt into buckets and wheelbarrows, moving the Hammond Street Senior Center rooftop garden to the Bangor Community Garden on Essex Street. The senior center will close its doors on Oct. 30, and the approximately 35 members of the Crusaders football team volunteered to move the 17 rooftop beds. The soil was put into wheelbarrows, which were emptied into a rooftop lift donated by Roof Systems of Maine, before being lowered into a dump truck donated by the Lou Silvers Construction Company of Veazie. The raised beds also were moved and loaded onto a trailer donated by master gardener Art Shaw. Next year, Hammond Street Senior Center garden members will continue to provide educational services to youth and adult gardeners while growing crops at the community garden that will be provided to area food banks.

### Learn to Skate sign-ups being held for programs at Bangor’s Sawyer Arena

The Bangor Parks and Recreation Department is accepting registrations for its Learn to Skate and Free-Style Skate Lessons for ages 4 and up. Session I is Nov. 8-Dec. 20 with no program on Nov. 29. Programs are held at Sawyer Arena on Sundays. Times and fees vary based on program chosen.

Learn to Skate (4:10-5:10 p.m.) \$80 residents/\$85 non-residents. Learn to skate will have a half hour of instruction and a half hour of supervised free skate. However, we will be limiting the first hour for students in Learn to Skate Levels 1-3.

The first hour will also include an adult Learn Basic Level 4-8 & Free-Style Skate Levels 1-6 (5:20-6:20 p.m.) \$95 resident/\$100 non-resident. These lessons will also be a half hour of les-

sons with a half hour of free skate to practice.

Students who would like to compete and test at Basic Levels 4-8 and Free-Style Skate 1-6 must be members of the United States Figure Skating Association (USFSA). Your fee for this program includes membership to USFSA. There is no extra fee and there is no obligation to compete.

Free-Style Skate Level 4-6 \$95 resident/\$100 non-resident & Synchronized Team Skating (6:20-7:20 p.m.) \$10 resident/\$15 non-resident This program is for students in Free-Style Skate 4-6, Synchronized team skating, and practice for the advanced skaters. Will follow the same format as the previous two programs.

Synchronized Team skating will be offered as an introductory offer to those students registered for a skating class (open to those who can skate forward and backward).
