Millinocket Regional Hospital is committed to providing the earliest detection possible and has invested in the full capability to identify and diagnose cancer at any stage. Our fully and highly accredited Diagnostic Imaging department provides a comprehensive range of screening services; from mammography, x-rays, CAT scans and MRIs to nuclear

medicine. Chapman Lab, a highly qualified and certified on-site laboratory, provides extensive cancer screening laboratory tests equal to those offered at larger facilities.

Once detected, surgeons Mark Kowalski, MD, and Stylianos Tsintzilonis, MD, have the knowledge, experience and extensive skills to perform a variety of surgical interventions, including lumpectomies, mastectomies, needle biopsies and lymph node dissections often associated with breast cancer, as well as surgical procedures for skin and gastrointestinal cancers.

When the team feels a patient would be best served by a specialist, as is the case

with lung cancer, urology-based cancers and metastatic cancers that affect multiple organs, they are referred to a surgeon who specializes in those areas.

Radiation and chemotherapy are

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alternative interventions that may be paired with a surgical procedure or implemented exclusively. Millinocket Regional Hospital has a collaborative agreement with Cancer Care of Maine, one of the few radiation treatment facilities in the State, to provide radiation treatments to our patients. Patients requiring chemotherapy and infusion services do not need to travel daily or weekly to receive their treatments; as they are provided locally

at MRH. Compassionate, highly-trained Certified Oncology Registered Nurse, Kim Faloon, administers a comprehensive range of chemotherapy treatments and infusions in a comfortable, relaxing atmosphere right here within the Katahdin Region.
